MAKE YOUR OWN GOOD DEEDS TREE

STEP 1

Colour the images provided and using a Pritt stick, glue to cardboard.



STEP 2

Carefully cut out the tree and leaves.



STEP 3

Slot the 2 tree trunks together through the center.



STEP 4

Now write good deeds on the back of each leaf and set aside.



STEP 5

Stick one leaf onto the tree every day using Pritt, encouraging children to perform one good deed per day during Ramadan. The goal is to see how many good deeds can be carried out by the end of Ramadan and finish with a fully bloomed tree.

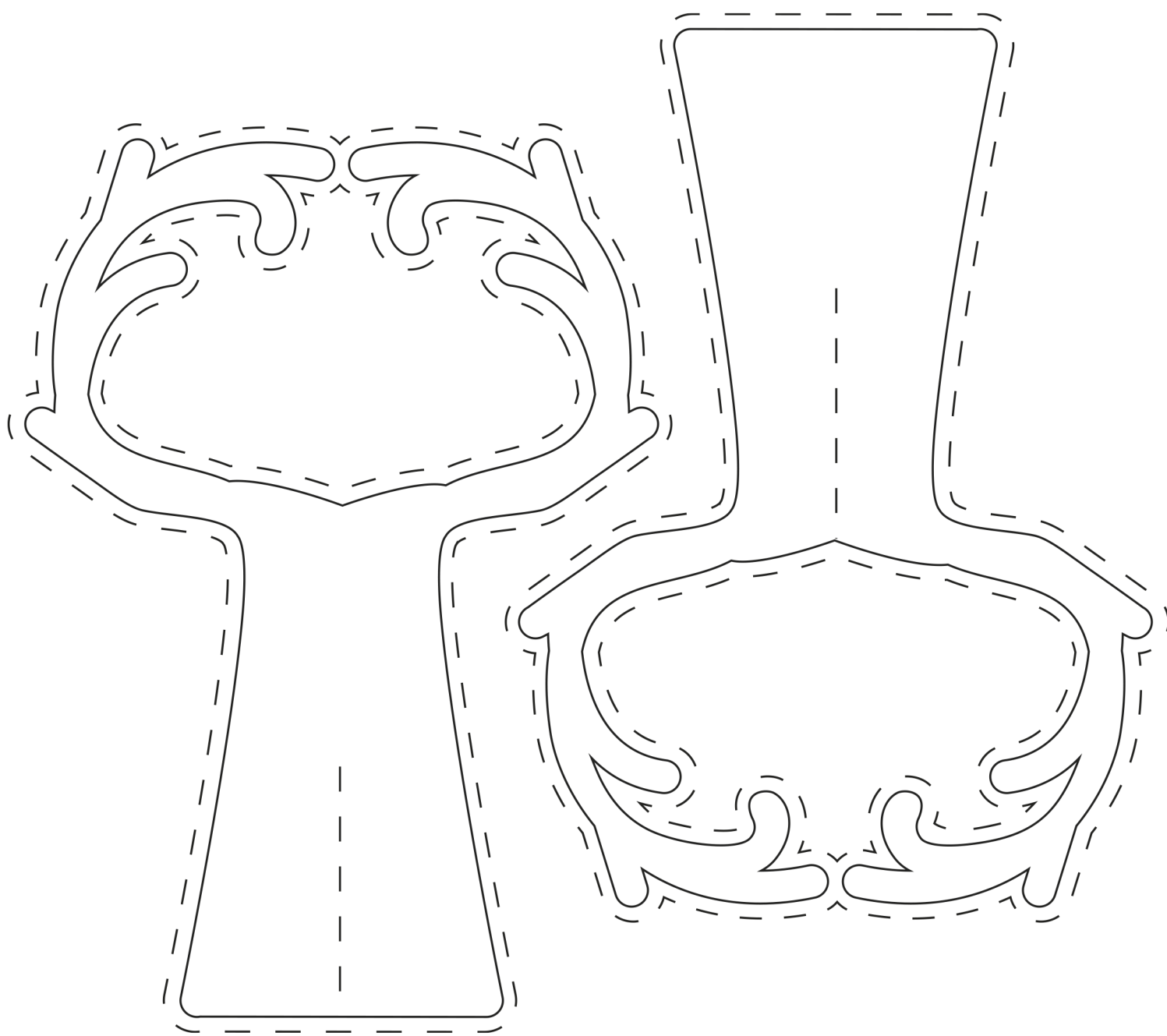

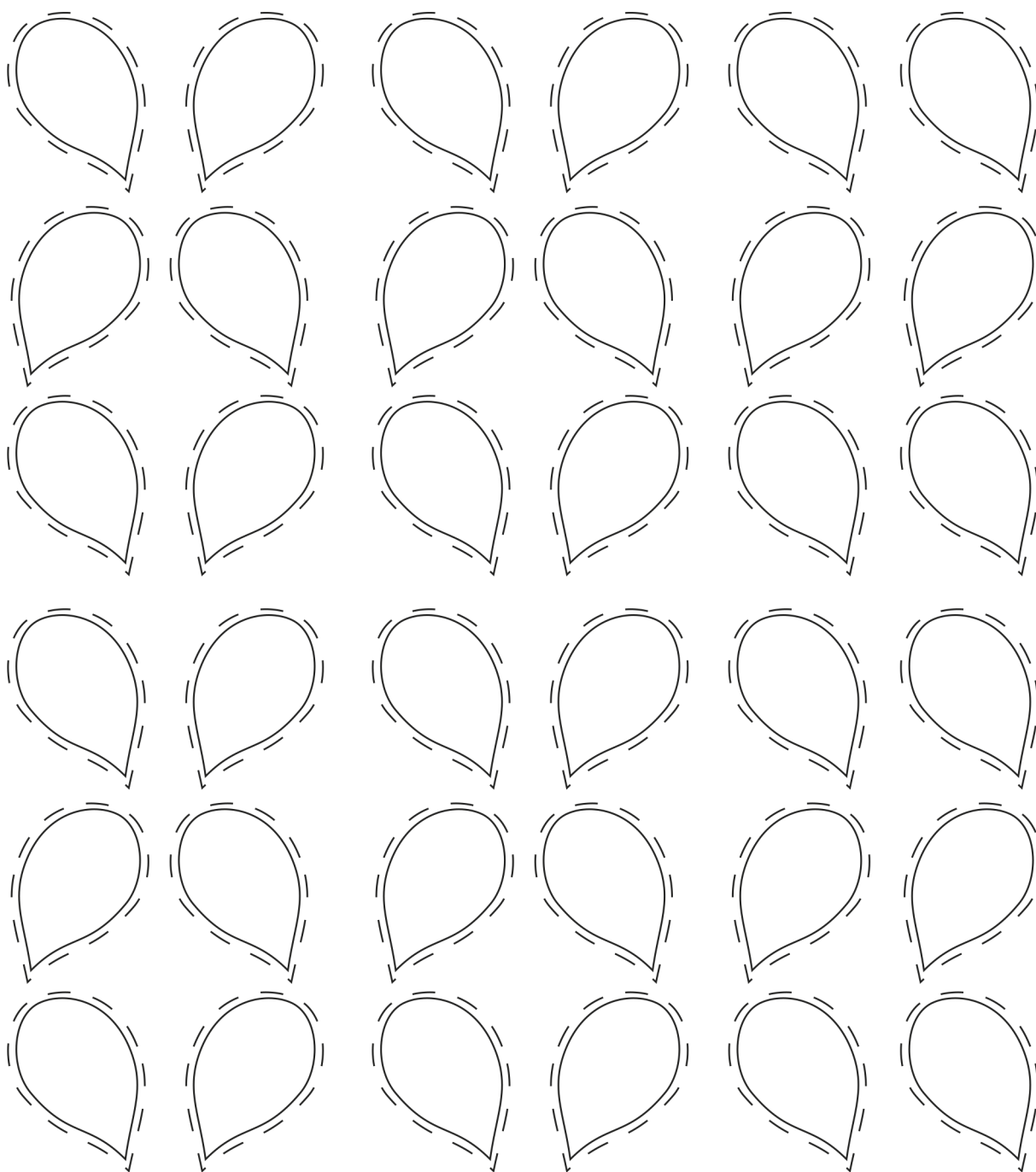
